

ORDINANCE NO. 93-1

ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING JURISDICTION AND DUTIES OF TOWN CONSTABLE

The Town Board of the Town of Liberty, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, pursuant to Section 60.22(4) of the Wisconsin Statutes, hereby establishes the jurisdiction and duties of the Town Constable and does ordain as follows:

Section 1. Jurisdiction and Duties. The Town Constable of the Town of Liberty, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, shall:

A. Cause to be enforced and prosecuted all violations of ordinances of the Town of Liberty.

B. Obtain necessary assistance as appropriate from other law enforcement agencies as provided by law.

C. Perform all other duties required by law.

Section 2. Non-Exclusivity.

A. Other Ordinance. Adoption of this ordinance by the Town Board shall not preclude the Town Board from adopting any other ordinance or providing for the enforcement of any other law or ordinance relating to the same or other matter by any other means.

B. Other Remedies. The jurisdiction and duties of the Town Constable as stated herein shall not preclude the Town Board

competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the remaining provisions or the application of this ordinance which shall be given effect without the invalid or unconstitutional provision or application.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect upon adoption and posting as required by law.
