AMENDMENT TO HIGHWAY ORDINANCE NO. 105

TOWN OF LIBERTY
MANITOWOC COUNTY, WISCONSIN

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. 105, HIGHWAY ORDINANCE

The Town Board of the Town of Liberty, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, in order to promote the public safety, general welfare and convenience, do ordain as follows:

Ordinance No. 105, Highway Ordinance, is amended and revised as follows:

1. Section 1.08 is amended as follows:

1.08 Culverts. Any culvert necessary for proper drainage shall be provided and installed by the owner of the real estate after elevation and location information is obtained from the Town Board. The minimum diameter of any culvert installed shall be eighteen (18) inches. The minimum length of any culvert installed shall be twenty (20) feet. Each culvert installed shall include end walls.

2. Section 4 is created as follows:

Section 4. Other Driveways. The standards set forth in Sections 1.02, 1.07, and 1.08 of this Ordinance shall apply to the construction of all driveways within the highway right-of-way in the Town of Liberty and which are not otherwise within the terms of Section 1. Prior to commencing construction within the highway right-of-way, the owner shall apply for and obtain a permit from the Town of Liberty on forms supplied by the Town Clerk.

3. Except as otherwise modified or amended by the terms of this ordinance, the terms of Ordinance No. 105, Highway Ordinance, are hereby ratified and confirmed.

4. This ordinance shall be effective upon posting as required by law.
