ORDINANCE NO. 97-

ORDINANCE TO ESTABLISH SPEED LIMIT AUTUMN RIDGE DRIVE

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Liberty, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, finds that Autumn Ridge Drive is located in a semiurban district in the Town of Liberty; and WHEREAS, the Town Board declares the necessity to establish a reasonable and safe speed different from that established by Wisconsin Statute;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Town Board of the Town of Liberty, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, pursuant to its authority under Section 349.11, Wis. Stat., in order to promote public safety and welfare, do ordain as follows:

- SPEED RESTRICTION. The speed restriction for Autumn Ridge Drive, a town highway, shall be 25 miles per hour.
- 2. <u>SIGNS</u>. The Town Chairperson or his designee is authorized and directed to install official signs necessary to effectuate the terms of this ordinance. Such signs shall be in conformity with the Uniform Traffic Sign Manual, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and all other rules and regulations.
- 3. **SEVERABILITY**. The provisions of this ordinance are severable. In the event any portion of this ordinance is determined to be unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, such determination shall not affect the remainder of this ordinance. The Town Board hereby declares its intent to have passed

all other provisions of this ordinance and the remainder of the ordinance shall not be affected by such determination.
